Immediate or delayed complications related to cataract surgery, trauma, and inherited eye conditions (Marfan syndrome, Pseudoexfoliation syndrome, and others) can lead to complex anterior segment disease.

Delayed-onset manifestations of endophthalmitis involving the anterior segment include hypotony, band keratopathy, and corneal opacification. This last condition is more common if the hypopyon was extensive and chronic. Posterior synechiae are commonly noted in both phakic and pseudophakic eyes.

The anterior segment of the eye can be damaged by trauma or sometimes during surgery for other problems like retina repair, glaucoma, or cataracts. Repairing these problems is called anterior segment reconstruction. Anterior segment reconstruction can prove to be a very effective and low-risk method to treat severe ocular trauma or the complications associated with a failed surgery, disease, or eye injury.

Diabetes mellitus (DM) has been emerging as one of the most serious health problems worldwide. Ocular complications of DM are currently one of the major causes of blindness in developed countries, among which diabetic retinopathy is relatively well studied and understood. However, although ocular surface complications of DM are common, diabetic complications of anterior segment of the eye, such as, cornea, conjunctiva, and lacrimal glands, are often overlooked.

Influence of diabetes mellitus on anterior segment of the eye

Materials and methods. The anterior segments of the eyes of 181 patients with diabetes mellitus were examined. The commonest finding in the lids was warts, followed by poliosis and chalazia, and, in the conjunctiva, tortuous conjunctival vessels inferiorly (36.50%), pterygium (14.92%), and pingueculum (14.37%).

Patterns of ocular complications became associated with certain lens properties, such as improper IOL size, steep anterior vaulting within the anterior chamber, inadequate polishing of the surface of the IOL, and inflexibility or excessive flexibility.

Anterior segment ischemia (ASI) is a potentially serious but rare complication of strabismus surgery. Among several risk factors, ASI occurs after strabismus surgery because of the nature of the anterior segment circulation. Disinsertion of rectus muscles leads to a decrease in the blood supply to the various anterior segment structures.

The complications included hypotony (68.6%), shallow anterior chamber (37.1%), hyphaema (10.0%), uveitis (5.75%), cataract (5.7%), endophthalmitis (4.3%) and button holed conjunctiva (1.4%).

Advanced phacoemulsification (phaco) technology and techniques, as well as intraocular lens (IOL) developments, have dramatically heightened expectations for the cataract patient; emmetropia and instant visual improvement without discomfort or redness is the new norm. In my opinion, few patients are specifically informed that retinal detachment occurs after 0.5-1 % of phaco procedures.
