To cite a chapter in a book in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author(s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

When you want to quote from a book chapter in your paper, you need to create a parenthetical in-text citation

Note: When citing in-text, it can be difficult if your eBook does not have a page number (most PDF books do). In this case, try to get as specific as possible by mentioning chapter, section, and paragraph numbers. ## **MLA Works Cited Page: Books // Purdue Writing Lab**

Citation to a case contained in an electronic service (e.g. Westlaw or Lexis) is permissible only when the case is not published in book form. Provide the case name, citation, court, decision date and docket or index number. If the source is Westlaw or Lexis, and access to both is available, cite both services:

## **Chapter in a Book - APA Citation Style, 6th Edition ...**

When citing a particular chapter from a book containing texts by various authors (e.g. a collection of essays), begin the citation with the author of the chapter and mention the book's editor (s) later in the reference. A page range identifies the chapter's location in the book:  
Format. Last name, Initials. (Year).

The main reason writers will cite a chapter of a book instead of the whole book is when the chapter is written by an author (s) different from the book's editor (s). An editor compiles a selection of articles written by other experts in the field.

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was

published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

Identifying the format, platform, or device (e.g., ebook, Kindle book, etc.) of a chapter in an authored ebook is no longer needed. A chapter in an authored ebook from an academic collection

should be treated as a chapter in an authored print book with the reference ending with the publisher.
