Many people who previously had too much income for the program are now eligible because of higher income limits.

What are the income limits for Basic Food

What Defines "Income" For Medicaid eligibility purposes, all income that one receives from any source is counted towards the income limit. This may include employment wages, alimony payments, pension payments, Social Security Disability Income, Social Security Income, gifts, and payments from annuities and IRAs.

The Washington Basic Food program (Basic Food) is a federally funded nutrition program to help low-income individuals and families buy food. This rule is a summary of the rules for Basic Food. (1) When you apply for Basic Food, we decide who is in your assistance unit (AU) based on the requirements under WAC 388-408-0034 and 388-408-0035 .

WAC 388-400-0040:

To figure out if you qualify for food stamps, Washington needs to know your: Household size: How many people you live and buy/make food with.; Income: How much money your household makes. This includes both earned income (the money you make from jobs) and unearned income (cash assistance, Social Security, unemployment insurance, and child support, etc.).

If you would like to apply for DSHS Basic Food Assistance (SNAP/EBT), please visit the Washington Connection website. Eligibility generally follows the income guidelines listed below: 2020 Poverty Guidelines for the 48 Contiguous States and the District of Columbia. For households with more than 8 persons, add \$373 for each additional person.

BFET - Workforce

Basic Food is a food and nutrition program for individuals & families who meet the income guideline (listed at right) afford healthier foods by providing monthly benefits to buy food. Basic Food will also qualify you for Free or Reduced School Meals for your child.

Washington state's Basic Food program - King County

(a) If your AU is categorically eligible as under WAC 388-414-0001, your AU does not have to meet the gross or net income standards in columns B and C of subsection (1) of this section. We budget your AU's income to decide the amount of basic food your AU will receive.

WAC 388-478-0060:

Families whose income meets state guidelines and who meet other criteria, may be able to receive a subsidy to offset some of their child care costs. If you are interested in learning more about the availability of child care subsidies in your county, please contact your DSS office.

Food stamps help low-income families and individuals purchase nutritious foods and groceries. If you live in Washington state and need help paying for groceries, you may apply for food stamps through a program called Basic Food. If you qualify, Basic Food will allot a certain amount of money to you each month to help pay for the cost of food.

(a) Your AU's income that we do not exclude under WAC 388-450-0015 is at or under two hundred percent of the federal poverty guidelines we use for department programs. (i) The federal government publishes the federal poverty guidelines on the health and human services website.

WAC 388-414-0001:

The income guidelines for SNAP in Washington are based on the number of people living in your household and the total income of everyone in that household. Your total household income must be at or below 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, according to the number of people in your household, in order to qualify for food stamps.
