Indication for this type of investigations are based on the suspicion that structural abnormalities (rectocele, enterocele, or intussusception/rectal prolapse) or functional abnormalities (poor opening of the anorectal angle by non-relaxing or contracting puborectalis during attempted defecation, poor anal sphincter relaxation, incomplete or prolonged evacuation of rectal content) might impede evacuation and be the cause of defecatory symptoms in at least some patients with chronic constipation.

There are many tests available currently to study anorectal motility disorders but it is not clear whether the tests identify the precise pathophysiologic abnormality. Commonly used tests are high-resolution anal manometry (HRAM), barium and MR defecography, balloon expulsion test (BET), and barostat testing for the rectal sensory function [22 , 26 , 30 , 31 , 32 , 33].

Anorectal disorders which often lead to fecal incontinence are a frequent problem especially in elderly patients. Direct risk factors for fecal incontinence are higher age, female sex and co-morbidity with reduced health status. Anorectal disorders cause significant socio-economic burden. Impairment of the structural and functional integrity of the anorectum are mostly multifactorial (integrity of the muscles, sensory function, stool consistency) leading to depression and fear with reduction ...

Anorectal sensitivity and compliance: visceral hypersensitivity, an exaggerated perception of stimuli encompassing both allodynia and hyperalgesia, is one of the main hallmarks of functional gastrointestinal disorders. 24 IBD patients with active or inactive disease have been shown to have continuous release of inflammatory mediators which can give rise to sensorimotor alterations in the gut, and development of visceral hypersensitivity.

Current perspectives on the diagnosis and management of ...

A new dynamic technique for the investigation of anorectal function has been developed. This involves radiological visualization of the rectum during voiding of a semisolid radio-opaque contrast medium, and simultaneous measurement of the intrarectal pressure and electrical activity of the external anal sphincter.
