To figure out if you qualify for food stamps, Massachusetts needs to know your: Household size: How many people you live and buy/make food with.; Income: How much money your household makes. This includes both earned income (the money you make from jobs) and unearned income (cash assistance, Social Security, unemployment insurance, and child

To apply for SNAP benefits, you need to provide personal information. This includes your Social Security number (if you have one), birth date, home address (if you have one), income, and expenses. SNAP has certain income guidelines. You can view the SNAP eligibility charts to find the guideline that applies to your household.

The maximum gross monthly income is 130 percent of the federal poverty level, and the maximum net monthly income is 100 percent of the federal poverty level. For instance, if your household only consists of one person, then the gross monthly income to be eligible for SNAP is \$1,287 (net \$990).

Food Stamps Eligibility - SNAP Program Eligibility Help

Because SNAP households are expected to spend about 30 percent of their own resources on food, your allotment is calculated by multiplying your household's net monthly income by 0.3,

SNAP Special Rules for the Elderly or Disabled | USDA-FNS

A standard deduction of \$167 for household sizes of 1 to 3 people and \$178 for a household size of 4 (higher for some larger households and for households in Alaska, Hawaii, and Guam). A dependent care deduction when needed for work, training, or education.
