The term post impressionist was coined by English artist and art critic Roger Fry in 1910 after many of the artists had died; none of them ever heard the term or used it themselves.

Although grossly underappreciated in his lifetime, Van Gogh was an impulsive and often spontaneous painter who embodied many of the ideals of the Post-Impressionist movement. In Portrait of Doctor Gachet, Van Gogh strove to elicit a complex mixture of emotions within the viewer, rather than portray a naturalistic description of the sitter.
