Under the Lemon Law, if you wish to claim a refund or replacement you must give written notice by certified mail to the manufacturer and its dealer or repairing agent. You must send this notice within sixty days after the express warranty ends, or within sixty days after the one-year period ends (measured as one year from the date the motor vehicle was delivered to the original owner), whichever occurs first.

If a new vehicle turns out to be defective and has not been properly repaired after a reasonable number of attempts, the law requires a refund or replacement vehicle. Only a small percentage of new vehicles will be declared lemons.

Alaska's lemon laws state that if the buyer of a vehicle finds a major fault in it – which the manufacturers are unable to fix even after four valid attempts by the vehicle manufacturer to repair it – the manufacturer is liable to repurchase or replace the faulty vehicle.

The Alaska car lemon law is enacted to protect consumers who purchase new vehicles that turn out to be lemons. By the lemon law definition, a lemon is a vehicle that is defective, beyond repair, with mechanical failings that are substantial, affecting initiation, use or safety. The law protects consumers from having to bare the financial responsibility of the faulty vehicle that was purchased.
