Unbolt and remove the Timing Belt Tension Pulley (left side of the engine). Using a box wrench, slightly move clockwise (1 degree) the Camshaft Pulley and remove the belt. This slight advance in the camshaft will allow some belt slack to ease new belt installation. Unbolt and remove the Belt Guide Pulley (lower, right side of the engine).
